South Korea	Immumgye Kodung Hakkyo Choeupchang (Upper Secondary Certificate) and one of: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Minimum of Year 3 GPA of 75%; or ■ College Scholastic Ability Test (CSAT) overall standard score of 300. 	
Taiwan	Senior High School Diploma with minimum Year 12 GPA of 80%	
Sri Lanka A Levels	Minimum 9 points for 3 A Level subjects. ie: CCC (Points calculated as follows: A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2 and E=1)
